Dear Friends,

Seventh-day Adventists believe strongly in Christian education. Wherever we have sent missionaries, we have established schools to educate the youth and prepare them for a life of Christian service. For this reason Wisconsin Academy has adopted the motto, "Fit to Serve" – Fit Mentally, Physically, and Spiritually. Compassion is at the core of our values and drives us to reach out to others.

As Christ has had compassion on us, we too reach out to others in Christian love. As we are transformed by His grace, ministry to others becomes central to our Christian walk and experience. For this reason the students and staff of Wisconsin Academy are actively preparing for part 2 of our ongoing mission project to the Philippines.

This coming spring, from March 6 – 22, we will travel to the island of Culion in the Philippines to conduct a mission project similar to what we did in 2016. We will hold an evangelistic series, conduct a vacation Bible school, provide a free medical/dental clinic, and build a church. In all of these activities, we will be partnering with our Filipino brothers and sisters and establishing ongoing relationships that will continue after our departure.

The Seventh-day Adventist members in the village of Bonongan currently worship in a small shelter that needs to be replaced with a larger solid structure. Working together with the local church members, we will build a cement block church that will allow for growth in the coming years. Work on the foundation should start in early February. When we arrive in March, we will start putting up the walls. Our project manager will be the same person we used in 2016. Several months before our arrival, we will hire two or three full time Bible workers to study with families in the community in preparation for the evangelistic meetings.

There are roughly 25 students who are planning to go on this mission project. Each student needs to raise \$1,800 which will cover both airfare and project expenses.
